PRIVACY NOTICE

The National Indigenous Australians Agency (the Agency) is collecting your personal information for the purposes of assessing and processing your application, administering grants, compliance and detection of fraud, research and analysis.

For the same purposes, we may disclose personal information to the parties listed at section 13.3 of the NAIDOC Local Grants Program Grant Opportunity Guidelines (the Guidelines). This includes those involved in the assessment of your application, contractors of the Commonwealth, Parliament and other government agencies. We may also use de-identified information for the purposes of reporting to other agencies, Parliament and the public.

Providing the requested information is voluntary. If you choose not to provide us with your information, you may not satisfy the eligibility criteria and:

- not receive preference in deciding which organisation we will fund (please see section 8.4 of the Guidelines)
- be deemed ineligible for this grant opportunity (please see section 4.1 of the Guidelines)
- be asked to provide alternative information.

The Agency will not provide the information collected from you to anyone else outside the Agency (other than the parties listed at section 13.3 of the Guidelines), unless you have given consent for us to do this, or we are authorised or required to do so by law.

The privacy and security of your personal information is important to us, and is protected by law. The Agency's <u>Privacy Policy</u> explains how the Agency handles and protects the information provided by you. The Agency's Privacy Policy also explains how you can request access to or correct the personal information we hold about you, and who to contact if you have a privacy enquiry or complaint.
